

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR INTERIOR BRICK LINER KITS FOR USE WITH SSDVT-3328 AND SSDVR-3328 GAS APPLIANCES

SHIPPING AND PACKING LIST

Package 1 of 1 contains:

- 1 - Rear Brick Liner Panel.
- 1 - Left Brick Liner Panel.
- 1 - Right Brick Liner Panel.
- 1 - Rear Inside Lintel.
- 1 - Hardware Kit.
- 1 - Installation Instructions.

GENERAL INFORMATION

This Simulated Brick Liner Kit (**Figure 1**) is for use only in the following models of fireplaces:

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1. Follow the procedure "TURNING OFF GAS TO UNIT", located on the Lighting Instructions pullout labels in the control compartment of the unit and in the Installation Instructions provided with the appliance.

Step 2. Refer to the appliance Care And Operations Instructions and gain access to and remove the front glass enclosure panel.

Step 3. Carefully remove the log set, and pull any ember materials back away from the firebox rear and side walls.

Step 4. Insert rear liner panel into firebox and position against rear wall of firebox.

Step 5. Carefully insert right liner panel into firebox against right side of firebox and rear panel. Engage locking hem of the liner panel with the locking flange of the rear liner panel (**Figure 2**). Fasten with provided screws (**Figure 3**). Be sure the front edge of the right panel is flush with the front edge of the fireplace.

Step 6. Repeat Step 5 for the left hand panel.

Step 7. Remove the existing lintel as shown in **Figure 4** by removing the two screws. Retain the screws, but discard the lintel.

Step 8. Install the lintel provided in the kit in the same location as the existing lintel with the existing screws.

Step 9. If desired, use high temperature black paint to touch up the screw heads securing the panels.

Step 10. Replace logs, restore ember bed materials to their original position and reinstall the front glass enclosure panel.

Step 11. Place the unit in operation by following the procedure "LIGHTING INSTRUCTIONS", located on the lighting instructions pullout labels in the control compartment of the unit and in the Care And Operations instructions provided with the appliance.

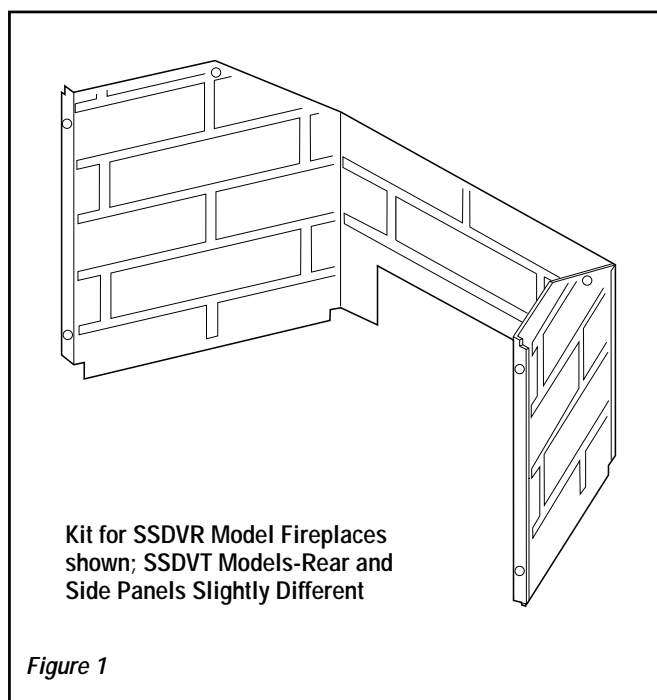
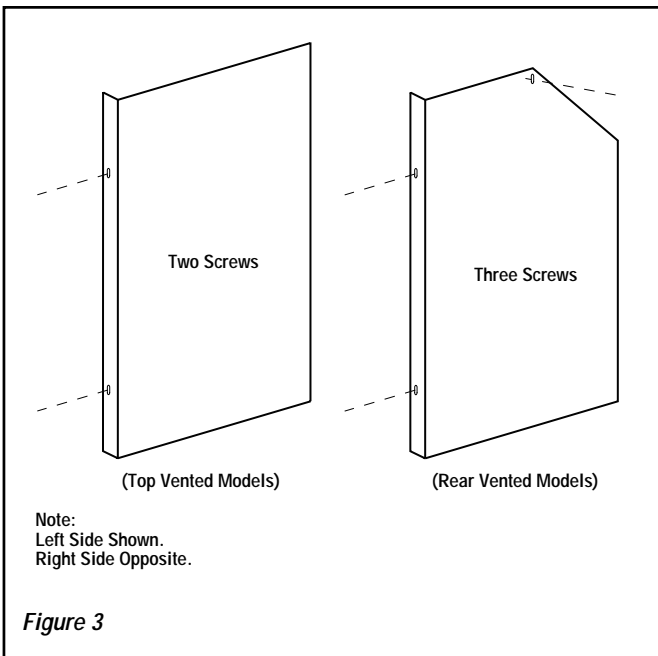
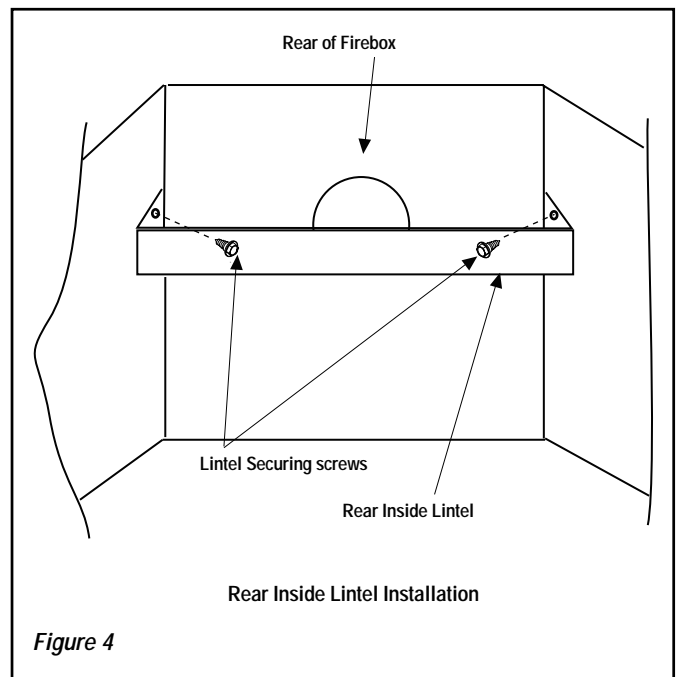
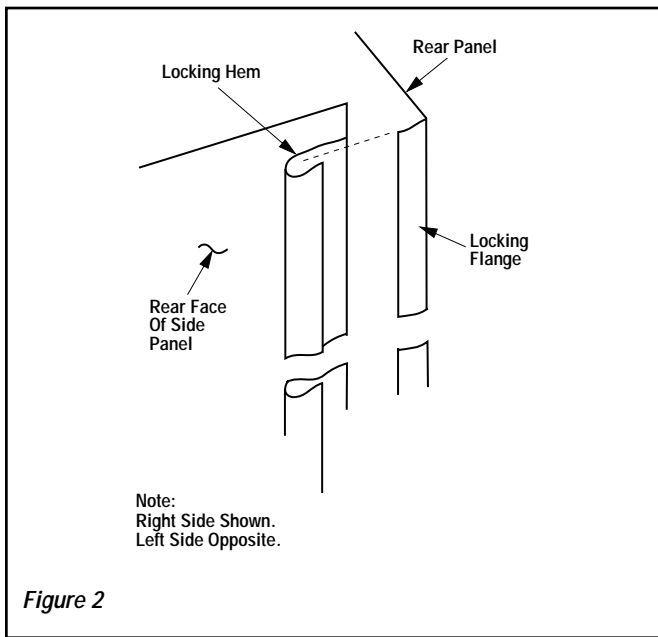
